Heavy Horse Division: Contact, Rules & Entry Form

Weigh In: Friday August 16, 2019 at 10:00am-4:00pm. If you cannot make this weigh-in please contact Janice Kruger, 250-613-8575.

Draft Horse Pull: \$30.00 per team per pull

Stalling: \$10.00 per horse per day

Cleaning Deposit: \$25.00 refundable cleaning deposit. ****This is not an optional fee.****

Exhibitor Passes: See registration form. (All members of the team will need a pass).

1. Boundary lines are 16 feet apart.
2. Length of pull is 14 feet; allowed two tries to make 14 feet. Any movement of the boat over 6 inches is considered a try.
3. All teams will be pulled pounds overweight.
4. Offset double trees and neck yolks are allowed.
5. Each team is allowed 2 helpers. Teamster and both helpers must stay behind double tree when team is pulling.
6. If helpers coach or interfere while the team is hooked to the boat, the team will be disqualified.
7. Teamster or hooker (evener) may ride on the front of the boat. There shall be no riding in the boat.
8. Line rule waived for the first 3 pulls.
9. While hooked to the boat the team must stay within the side lines. If the team steps on or over the side lines they will be disqualified and allowed their previous completed pull.
10. A teamster may ask the judge to center the boat before hooking. If there is no means available to center the boat, the Judge may waive off the sideline rule and ask the teamster to center the boat during the pull.
11. If a break in harness of equipment occurs, there will be a time limit of 15 minutes to repair the break and complete the pull.

12. Deliberate stalling will result in disqualification.
13. Deliberate jerking of the load is prohibited. Judge to warn teamsters. If the infraction occurs, the team is eliminated from the pull and allowed their previous completed pull.
14. Once a team is hooked, started into or asked to pull, the team must stay between the guidelines until the pull is completed and the team is unhooked.
15. The pin and chain laid out flat measures 14 feet. Pin must be out completely to qualify as a pull.
16. The team must pull their weight to be eligible for prize (hookup) money.
17. Teamsters are not to argue or harass the judge. To do so will result in instant disqualification and forfeiture of all prizes. Any complaint should be made to the pull committee.
18. Unethical use of drugs will result in disqualification and forfeiture of all winnings.
19. The committee reserves the right to conduct a spot check by a veterinarian for contesting teams.
20. JUDGES DECISION IS FINAL!

Heavy Horse Prize Payout

For both Friday and Saturday:

1st Place \$1,100

2nd Place \$800

3rd Place \$500

Hookup money for each day is \$200. Top three placing will not receive hookup money.
